

2010 UTAH NRA APPROVED LONG RANGE MATCHES

MATCH DATE: Saturday:

January 23, 2010, February 27, 2010, March 27, 2010, April 24, 2010, May 22, 2010, August 28, 2010, October 23, 2010, & November 27, 2010, **weather permitting. It is imperative that you check the USRPA web site before you leave home to make sure the match is still on.**

LOCATION: Wendover, Utah.

DIRECTIONS: See www.usrpa.org or attached directions.

FACILITIES: Wendover, Utah and West Wendover, Nevada are the nearest cities with motels, restaurants, gambling, etc.

NOTE: Competitors should bring their own food and water. A porta-a-pottie will be located in the target pit.

SPONSOR: Utah State Rifle & Pistol Association

TIME: Firing will commence following squadding assignments at 0900. The gate will be accessible at 0800. The gate combination will be 0000.

RULES: Current NRA HIGH POWER Rifle Rules will apply.

ELIGIBILITY: This is an Approved Match open to any individual who is a member of the Utah State Rifle and Pistol Association or their respective State Associations. A \$5.00 nonmember fee for this match will be charged for those without proof of current Utah State Rifle & Pistol Association membership or in their respective State Association. USRPA membership is \$25 per year. Applications will be available at the range. (\$5.00 for Juniors).

CLASSIFICATION: Competitors holding an NRA High Power Rifle Long Range & F-Class classification will shoot in their respective classes. All unclassified shooters will shoot in the Master class (Rule 19.2). Assigned Classification (Rule 19.6), or Temporary Classification (Rule 19.2) may be used in making entry in this match.

REGISTRATION LIMITED: Entries will be limited to the first 30 competitors to register. Registration cards are available online at http://www.usrpa.org/High_Power/high_power.html. All pre-registrations must be received by the Wednesday before the match. Late registrations will be accepted at the range prior to the squadding at 0800, up to range capacity.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES: Competitors desiring to shoot in this match **NEED** to contact Elwood Powell to let him know their intent no later than the Wednesday, 5:00 p.m., prior to the match. If on that Wednesday, there are insufficient shooters preregistered, the match will be canceled and prepaid fees returned. If canceled, those preregistered shooters will be notified. Cancellation will also be posted on www.usrpa.org/highpower.

FEES:

Total entry fees are as follows:

Fee for Adults: \$25.00. (\$20.00 if received on or before Wednesday before the match).

Fee for Juniors: (Through the year they turn 20) \$ 15.00. (\$10.00 if received on or before Wednesday before the match).

Challenge fee is \$2.00

Registration cards are available online at http://www.usrpa.org/High_Power/high_power.html. All pre-registrations must be received by the Wednesday before the match. Late registrations will be accepted at the range prior to the squadding at 0900, up to range capacity.

OPEN BOLT INDICATOR: The use of an open bolt indicator is mandatory (Rule 3.21). They are available for \$1.00 from the match director

RIFLE CATAGORIES: All with No Muzzle brakes, and .33 caliber or less.

Any Rifle / Any Sight or F-class

Any Rifle / Any Sight or F-class

Any Rifle / Metallic Sight or F-Class

TARGETS: 1000 yard - LR target, and 1,000 yard - LR "F" class target.

TARGET PULLERS: No target pullers will be provided. Each competitor will pull targets unless a suitable substitute is approved by the Match Director. Those competitors who fail to perform their pit duties will be disqualified.

SIGHTING SHOTS: Unlimited sighting shots will be allowed for each fired match within the time period designated below. Sighting shots which are allowed for each match must be taken and scored. Sighting shots may be converted for score in consecutive, reverse order that they were fired in, at the discretion of the shooter.

SCORING: Competitors will score for each other. Those competitors who fail to perform their scoring duties may be disqualified.

COURSE OF FIRE:

MATCH 1: Slow Fire Prone. Any Rifle/Any Sights (unlimited sighting shots, 20 shots for record in 30 Minutes. Coaching is allowed for sighting shots).

MATCH 2: Slow Fire Prone. Any Rifle/Any Sights (2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record in 22 Minutes. No Coaching allowed).

MATCH 3: Slow Fire Prone. Any Rifle/Any Sights (2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record in 22 Minutes. No Coaching allowed).

Note, the relay will be considered complete when all shooters have fired 20 shots per record, even if time remains.

AWARDS: There must be 5 or more entries in a class for an award. If there are not enough entries for class awards, awards will only be given out to the overall top three shooters per match. Competitors may be combined with the next higher class when there are less than 5 competitors per class. If there are fewer than 5 High-Masters entered, they will fire for overall awards only. The Master class will not be combined with the High-Master class. Awards will be provided for overall winner.
